### **Year 8 Enterprise Challenge – Monday 13<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020**

We are very proud of our applied learning experiences offered at our academy, and one of the highlights of the year is our fantastic Enterprise Week. Although this cannot run as normal this year, we are delighted to announce that a Year 8 enterprise challenge will still go ahead on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July. The challenge will replace home learning during this period. All students must take part. This letter contains some important information to allow your son/daughter to prepare before next week.

#### **Burger Bonanza**

Full details of the Burger Bonanza Challenge will be posted on Show My Homework on the above dates. A summary of the challenge is as follows: students will design, cook and package a new burger to meet the needs of a given target market. After some initial research of burgers currently available to buy from restaurants and supermarkets, students will decide upon their own burger recipe. They will name their burger, design its wrap and outer packaging, as well as making the burger itself. Students will submit their enterprise entries via photos to Mrs Thorpe on SMHW.

#### **Resource pack**

To ensure students have all the materials they need, a resource pack will be posted to every student later this week. These materials should be kept safe over the weekend and used as part of the challenge next week.

#### **Tesco voucher**

Finally, all Year 8 students working from home will be sent a £5 Tesco voucher to their school email address. This must only be used to purchase ingredients needed to make the burger. You can print off the voucher or show it at the check-out using a smart phone. Key worker students who will be completing the challenge in the academy will not receive a voucher as the ingredients will be provided.
