

16 to 19 tuition fund statement David Nieper Academy 2021-2022

2020/2021 Review

2020/2021 - 16 to 19 tuition fund income = £5175

Initial cost of 10 one to one online tutorial sessions for 16 students = £4200.

Spend on laptops for sixth form - £18100

Carry over to 2021/2022– nil

Last year we invested heavily in laptop provision and all post 16 students who required the loan of a laptop have received this throughout the academic year. Full IT support and support with Internet connexion is provided on an ongoing basis. Last year we also used the online platform My Tutor to provide 10 X 1:1 tutoring for students in Maths and English.

2021/2022 Plan

We currently have 44 students in the Sixth form. This year specifically, the additional funds received will be used to purchase additional one to one tuition for those students still working towards GCSE Maths or English. This includes one student for GCSE English and 15 students for GCSE maths. The Academy has chosen to use both in school 1:1 Maths and English Academic Tutors to deliver this as well as online tutoring via the My Tutor platform. Students will receive one 1:1 session per week in the run up to November resits. Once we have results from these, we will then also use My Tutor to add to the support children receive.

We have used MyTutor to support our one-to-one tuition, an organisation that we had previously successfully worked with on a pupil premium initiative. After 10 initial one to one sessions full evaluation will take place and if any students feel that they would benefit from additional ongoing 121 tuition provision this will be arranged.
