

16 to 19 tuition fund statement David Nieper Academy 2020-2021

We currently have 35 students in the Sixth form. David Nieper Academy has received £5175 from the 16 to 19 tuition fund 2020-21 to support the catch up and consolidation of teaching & learning of Students in the sixth form impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. We have invested heavily in laptop provision and all post 16 students who required the loan of a laptop have received this throughout the academic year. Full IT support and support with Internet connexion is provided on an ongoing basis.

Specifically, the additional funds received have been used to purchase additional one to one tuition for those students still working towards GCSE maths and or English. This includes six students for GCSE English and 13 students for GCSE maths of whom three students are completing both courses. The Academy has chosen to use MyTutor to support our one to one tuition, an organisation that we had previously successfully worked with on a pupil premium initiative. After 10 initial one to one sessions full evaluation will take place and if any students feel that they would benefit from additional ongoing 121 tuition provision this will be arranged.

16 to 19 tuition fund income = £5175

14 laptops on loan to students who do not have access to a device, in addition to laptops students have purchased using the 16-19 bursary where appropriate.

Initial cost of 10 one to one online tutorial sessions for 16 students = £4200.

Additional sessions will be provided if students feel this would be of benefit to their progress and confidence in these subject areas up to and above the remaining £1000 if required.
